

# A High Potential Ecosystem





# A favourable ecosystem to scale digital solutions

Considering Paris Region's positioning as the number one economic region in Europe, its weight in the French economy, and the concentration of many strategic private and public decision-making centers, Paris Region has become a prime target for cyber-attacks. To increase its resilience and that of the companies operating in the Region, Paris Region designed a comprehensive cyber security roadmap focusing on 3 main efforts: supporting the development of innovative and critical cyber technologies, being recognized as a partner for businesses operating in Cyber and protecting SMEs and midcaps, and training tomorrow's cyber talents.

On the national level, the French government launched in February 2021 a National Cyber Strategy with an investment plan totalling more than €1Bn (€720M of which is public funding) aimed at spurring innovation and strengthening France's resilience. This strategy has led to the launch of the Campus Cyber in Puteaux and to new startup support mechanisms (e.g., the Cyber Booster).

# A fast-growing market

By and large, the ever-growing threat of cybercrime is driving opportunity for cybersecurity providers. The French market for Cloud solutions and services for instance was close to the €16Bn mark in 2021, growing by 15.5%. By 2025, it should continue its strong momentum to reach a total business volume of €27Bn.

According to a report published by Wavestone, 2022 was a record year for France which counted 166 startups in cyber as well as 24 scale-ups. Ledger became France's first unicorn in cybersecurity after raising more than €380M in the summer of 2021. France's top cyber startups include: CybelAngel, Datadome, GitGuardian, Tehtris, Sekoia, MailinBlack.

Paris Region now homes more than 60% of all French cyber startups.

"As a U.S. Cyber publisher, we viewed Paris Region as a fast-growing market for cyber applications with a lot of potential. When we expanded, we had at heart to make Tanium a real French entity. We partnered with local startups, with the Campus Cyber, and recruited talents locally. Building such strong ties with the local ecosystem was pivotal in supporting our growth and strengthening our outreach to other European markets."

# Certifications for international companies

For investors interested in expanding their cyber and digital trust solutions to Paris Region, certification provides a competitive advantage because it attests to the security and robustness of a solution, thus reassuring potential buyers. The authority in charge of desining the technical certification is the National Information Systems Security Authority (ANSSI).

The evaluations are performed by licensed laboratories. It is the responsibility of the sponsor who applies for the certification of an IT product to choose a laboratory licensed by the ANSSI.

By and large, the French private sector welcomes foreign cyber security solutions that can help them secure their business processes with packaged solutions and practical tools.



# A Highly-Skilled Talent Pool

More than 75,000 talents in cyber will need to be recruited by 2025 in France. Paris Region has renewed focus on academic and apprenticeship programs which play a major role in unlocking cyber talents. The Region's counts 43 Cyber Schools among which:

Ecole 2600 is in Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines, a bastion of cybersecurity in Paris Region, which is home to more than 17,000 companies. This location fosters a consistent dialogue between teachers, students and industries, which contributes to the dynamism and uniqueness of the campus. With its unique apprenticeship, the school prepares students to become Data, System, and Network Security Experts.

# Leading Regional Cyber Initiatives

Digital Transformation is a "must" for the growth and expansion of any business. But with the expansion of digitalization, companies have also grown more vulnerable in the face of cyber-attacks. To position itself at the forefront of this issue, Paris Region has led several initiatives such as: financial support for the opening of the Campus Cyber, active support for the development and operation of Systematic and the creation of a regional Computer Security Incident Response Team (CSIRT).

# Supporting innovation through clusters and public-private partnerships

Building on its favorable ecosystem of academia, talents, researchers, and access to funding, Paris Region has become the number one region for cyber in France and accounts for 54% of cybersecurity employees in France. It concentrates 31% of wealth creation and gathers more than 1,2M companies on its territory, including more than 2,000 small and medium-sized businesses, 250 large companies and major decision-making centers, not to mention government agencies and local authorities (1,300). This concentration of expertise and talent availability led to the development of the innovation and technology cluster Systematic, comprised of:

- 900+ members including 550 SMEs, universities and 140 large corporations, 160 academic / research labs and universities
- 20 investors and 30 institutuional partners
- 7 DeepTech hubs: Data Science & Artificial Intelligence, Cyber & Security (& Defense) incl. Blockchain, Digital Infrastructure, Advanced Engineering & Computing, Optics & Photonics including Quantum Computing, Open Source, Drones

Paris Region has also been actively supporting major R&D projects on the future of cybersecurity among which: the Paris QCI (Quantum Communication Infrastructure) project partly financed by Paris Region and involving private corporations such as Orange, Thales (Thales SIX GTS and Thales TRT), Quandela, KETS Quantum Security, CryptoNext, VeriQloud, LIP6 (Paris), Institut d'Optique Graduate School, and Telecom Paris.

# Paris Region's Computer Security Incident Response Team (CSIRT)

Following attacks on several of its critical infrastructure, Paris Region announced in 2022 the creation of a regional Computer Security Incident Response Team (CSIRT) dedicated to providing support to local authorities suffering a cyber-attack, but also to inform, train and help small and medium-sized businesses in Paris Region. Planned to be effective by the summer of 2023, the CSIRT will rely on a network of accredited cyber experts who will cover the entire spectrum of attacks and can be mobilized rapidly.

"The Systematic cluster leads an ecosystem of more than 900 members made up of large companies, SMEs, startups, and academic players. Systematic's strength lies in this diversity. In creating a dedicated Cyber hub, the Systematic cluster has fostered, over time, a group of players that are extremely effective and recognized worldwide. Thanks to this visibility, cyber players know that investing in France is a catalyst for their acceleration, development, and growth."





# Dos

- Contact Choose Paris Region to access free and confidential services to expand your business
- Network as early as possible with clusters, local startups, schools, local authorities. They can help support your business in the beginning.
- Hire local talents to ensure high-quality customer service is delivered.
- Bring your English-speaking experts to the table, as English is widely spoken in this sector in France.

### Don'ts

- Forget to do your research when you enter the European market, as there are many regulations that your customers must comply with.
- Underestimate the importance of recruiting talents outside of your area of expertise. Mix your team with younger profiles that you will train.
- Overlook the fact that the French market for technology solutions is structured around integrators.
- Forget to develop strong ties with the Fortune 500 companies in Paris Region as they will be a catalyst for your growth in France and in Europe.
